About the College:

The college was established in 1966 in the historic town of Naragund under the patronage of the Municipality through the dedicated efforts of Late F. M. Hasabi, Late L. S. Patil, and Late S. F. Patil, under the name Shri Siddeshwar Arts College, Naragund. The Swamiji of Hiremath, Panchagraha Gudda, generously donated 46 acres of land, which significantly contributed to the physical and financial development of the institution.

On 22 March 1986, the college was taken over by the Government of Karnataka. Following the government takeover, the institution expanded its academic offerings by introducing Arts, Commerce, and Science streams. In the academic year 2025–26, the college has 30 full-time faculty members, 30 guest faculty members, and 4 non-teaching staff. A total of 1,284 students are enrolled in the Arts, Commerce and Science undergraduate programmes, while 158 students are pursuing Postgraduate studies in Commerce, Physics, Mathematics, History, and Economics. The institution consistently maintains over 90 percent results at both Undergraduate and Postgraduate levels. The college is supported by a team of experienced faculty members and provides essential academic facilities, including a well-equipped library and scholarship support for students. Student development is actively promoted through NSS, NCC, Rover and Rangers, cultural activities, and sports, ensuring the holistic development of learners.

In the 4th Cycle NAAC Re-accreditation (2022–23), the college was awarded an 'A' Grade with a CGPA of 3.25, emerging as the highest-scoring government college in North Karnataka. The institution has also become eligible for RUSA funding, marking a significant milestone in its institutional development.

Academic Programs:

At present, the college offers Undergraduate programmes in B.A., B.Sc., & B.Com. A Postgraduate Study Centre was established in the academic year 2011–12. In 2024–25, B.Com. (BFSI – Banking, Financial Services and Insurance) programme was introduced with an intake capacity of 60 students. Final-year students of this programme are provided with practical training along with a minimum monthly stipend, enabling them to gain industry-oriented experience and enhance their employability skills.

Research and Development Cell

The Research and Development (R&D) Cell of our college is dedicated to fostering a robust culture of academic inquiry and innovation among both faculty and students. It serves as a pivotal platform for enhancing the quality of research through specialized workshops and training sessions. By bridging the gap between theoretical knowledge and practical application, the R&D Cell continues to empower scholars to contribute meaningfully to their respective fields.
